Agromet bulletin for farmers

PORT BLAIR, SEPT 24/--
/ The Central Island Agricultural Research Institute has released the agromet bulletin for farmers for the period from Sept 25 to Sept 29. In the bulletin, CIARI forecast cloudy weather with moderate to heavy rainfall in the next five days in Andaman and Nicobar Islands.

The maximum temperature will be 28.5 to 31.0 oC with minimum temperature of 22.7 to 24.0 oC, whereas the maximum and minimum relative humidity is expected to be in the range of 79 to 84 % and 77 to 83 %, respectively in Andaman and Nicobar Islands. Wind speed of 13.0 to 33.3 kmph is expected from South Westerly direction.

In South Andaman (Blocks: Prothrapur, Little-Andaman and Ferrargunj), farmers have been advised to observe for rodent movements in paddy field and maintain thin film of water at 3 to 5cm in rice main field, observe for powdery mildew in vegetable (Bhendi or cowpea) and use

neem oil on rain free days for its control, prepare chilli nursery in upland area with protection from direct impact of rainfall, harvest the prepared vermi-compost from the pit and store for future use and monitor for Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD) in goat and consult the local veterinary doctor.

Farmers in North and Middle Andaman (Blocks: Rangat, Mayabunder and Diglipur) have been advised to observe for rodent movements in paddy field and maintain thin film of water at 3 to 5cm in rice main field, observe for powdery mildew in vegetable (Bhendi or cowpea) and use neem oil on rain free days for its control, prepare chilli nursery in upland area with protection from direct impact of rainfall, harvest the

prepared vermi-compost from the pit and store for future use and monitor for Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD) in goat and consult the local veterinary doctor. In Nicobar (Blocks: Nan-Cowrie, Car-Nicobar and Campbell-Bay), farmers have been advised to observe for rodent movements in paddy field and maintain thin film of water at 3 to 5cm in rice main field, observe for powdery mildew in vegetable (Bhendi or cowpea) and use neem oil on rain free days for its control, prepare chilli nursery in upland area with protection from direct impact of rainfall, harvest the prepared vermi-compost from the pit and store for future use and monitor for Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD) in goat and consult the local veterinary doctor.
