## Exposure visit for students of Kendra Vidyalaya-2 at ICAR-CIARI



**SRI VIJAYA PURAM, OCT 28/--/** An educational excursion was organized for 125 eighth-grade students from Kendra Vidyalaya No. 2, Mini Bay, accompanied by six faculty members, to explore the ongoing Integrated Farming System, Fisheries, and Crop Science activities at the Garacharma Research Complex of ICAR-CIARI in Port Blair on October 28, 2024.

Dr. T. Subramani, Senior Scientist and Head in Charge of the Natural Resource Management Division provided hands-on experience in topics such as Organic Farming, Integrated Farming Systems, and Watershed Management. Dr. J. Praveenraj, scientist, elaborated on freshwater ornamental fish and the concept of fish spas. Shri Shyam Sundar Rao, Sr Technician showcased microplots featuring various rice types. The students expressed their enthusiasm for the knowledge gained during their visit to ICAR-CIARI and engaged with the scientists to clarify their queries.
