Kavaratti: Cycling from Kerala to Kashmir, Lakshadweep's very own \*Muhammed Yaseen\* from Kadmat Island has made history by becoming the first islander travel to Kashmir from Lakshadweep on a cycle. Yaseen cycled through the heart of the country

to spread the message that a healthy person should donate blood every three months.

He covered 3670 kilometers in 38 days from May 5 till June 11 to complete the ride. Yaseen is the son of \*Shri. Cheriya Koya and Smt. A.C. Beebi of Kadmat\*. Yaseen started his solo cycle journey from Kerala and completed his trip in 38 days. He cycled through Karnataka, Goa, Maharashtra, Gujarat, Rajasthan, Haryana, New Delhi, Punjab etc and



finally reached Kashmir, the heaven on earth.

Yaseen ended his ride at Khardungla the highest pass, motorable pass in the world on June 11. All through his trip, he relied on petrol pumps, Mosques, Gurudwaras etc for sleeping and for having

Mubassina won her first medal through a long jump bronze at South Zone Championship, Kozhikode in 2021. She had also won gold in Javelin Throw in that championship.

She shifted to Androth as a paying guest to receive better training several coaches based in that area. She joined Malabar Sports Academy for a year following the South Zone Championship. Mubassina, who has recently passed the Class 10 examinations, is all set to pursue her higher secondary education in Lakshadweep.

Lakshadweep administration is operating five all weather ships for ensuring passenger connectivity between various islands and Kochi. In this regard, ships operated by Lakshadweep Administration have to undergo regular dry dock repairs and other voyage repairs on need basis as per the norms of Directorate General of Shipping. Recently, for improving the shipping operations in Lakshadweep, the operation and maintenance of vessels has been handed over to Shipping Corporation of India.

Out of five ships, three are currently in service for the people of Lakshadweep and connecting people betweenislands and Kochi. On 8th July 2022, MV Arabian Sea sailed from Kochi to Kavaratti and Agatti with 11 seats vacant. On 17th July 2022, MV corals sailed from Kochi to Bitra, Chetlat, Kiltan, Kadmat, Amini, Agatti and Kavaratti with 75 vacant seats. And on 19th July 2022, MV Arabian Sea sailed from Kochi to Agatti, Kavaratti, Bitra, Chetlat and Kiltan with 47 vacant seats. It is evident that many unsold tickets were there in the recent voyages and this clearly indicates the optimal planning and utilization of voyages of ships considering the requirement of the local population.

For facilitating the hassle-free movement of Hajj Pilgrims, Lakshadweep Administration had made special voyages and ensured timely movement of 142 Pilgrims from various islands of Lakshadweep to Kochi. Hajj pilgrims are now expected to return back to their respective islands by 23rd July, 2022. Lakshadweep Administration has made special voyage plans for facilitatingHajjPilgrims to reach their respective islands from Kochi on time.

Requirements of students have been taken careby coordinating with education department and all requests of students for attending examinationshave been met by the Administration. In order to facilitate movement of students from various islands studying in Jawahar Navadoya Vidyalaya, Minicoy Island, additional voyages have been made available to ensure hassle free movement of students. The NEET exam conducted on 17.07.2022 in Kavaratti Island, Lakshadweep was attended by 130 students and Administration has ensured hassle free movement of students along with their parents/guardians from various islands to Kavaratti.

Out of the two ships under repairs, MV Kavaratti had met with a fire accident in December 2021 and currently undergoing major repairs under the supervision of Shipping Corporation of India. MV Lakshadweep Sea was under study to meet the stability criteria in consultation with IRS and dry dock of Lakshadweep Sea is due as well. Shipping Corporation of India in association with Cochin Shipyard Limited is in the process of allocation of dry dock for scheduled repairs of Lakshadweep Sea. These two ships are under repair in order to meet the safety requirements for safe journey of People of Lakshadweep.

Inspite of the continuous efforts made by Lakshadweep Administration, there are ill-intended news spread by certain elements with an intention to spread hatred and panic among the community. Lakshadweep Administration has been taking all efforts to ensure smooth and efficient operations of the ships under the guidance of Hon'ble Administrator.
